


# World Cup Superfinal 2021

#### Normal Report Back Procedure

When you land, your live tracker will detect your landing and, a few minutes later, will emit a siren sound and display a menu:

- Retrieve Needed (no "classic" retrieve available, you will get informations by SMS from HQ)
- Retrieve Not Needed (normal option to use, you use public transport)
- Require Assistance (only choose, if you are injured; this option will be treated as a call to the emergency services).

After a delay, you will receive an acknowledgement on your live tracker; until this acknowledgement is received, you cannot consider yourself reported back. If you move, or your status changes, or you choose an incorrect option, simply report back again to give the organisation the most up to date information. If you cannot obtain an acknowledgement, you can report back by SMS. Simply send a message containing your pilot number and your UTM X and Y coordinates to the SMS Check-in number. The SMS can contain other supplementary infor-

After a delay, you will receive an acknowledgement SMS; until this acknowledgement is received, you cannot consider yourself reported back.

### Report Back with SMS-System

Send an SMS with the text "para stop" (without quotes) to +41 79 381 60 10 You can add additional information after "para stop" to the message. For example you could

send "para stop Landed in Ilanz".

#### Confirmation message

You have to get an automatic confirmation message. If not, the Report Back failed!.

Official Carrier

If both Report Back possibilities fail, you need to report back using the Retrieve Voice Phone.
